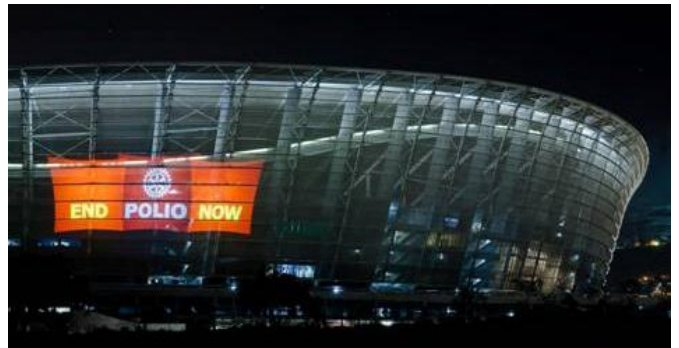

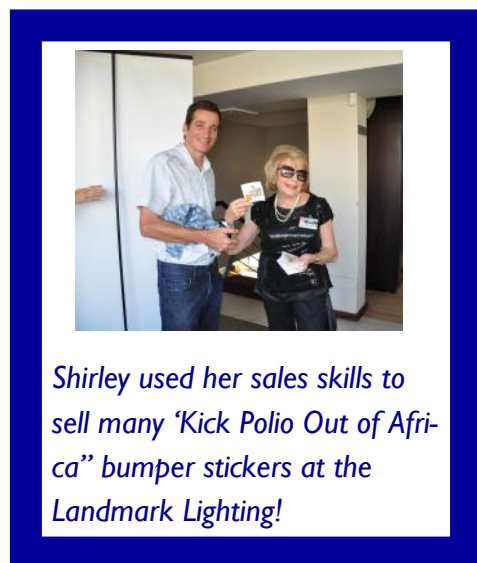

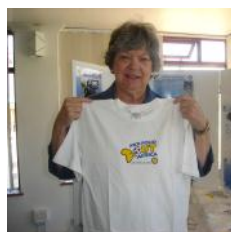


The BIG MAN visits!
